Special Character and Mercy Values

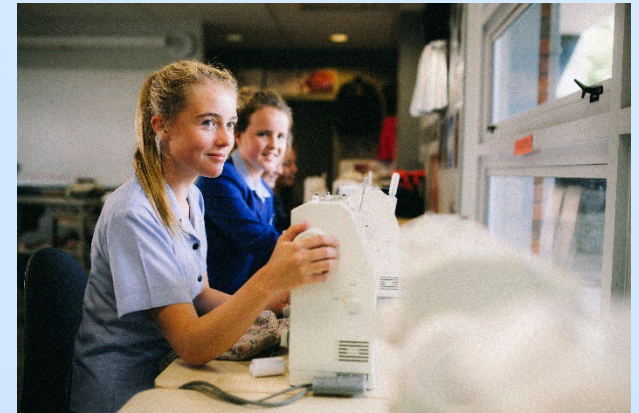

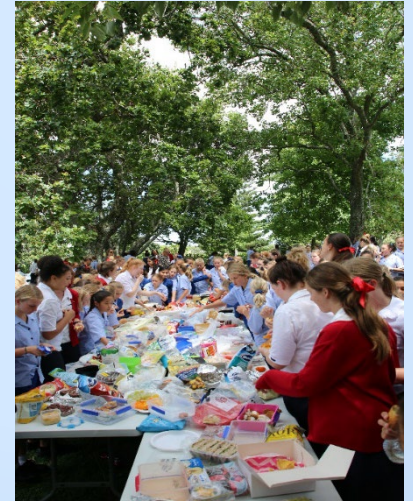

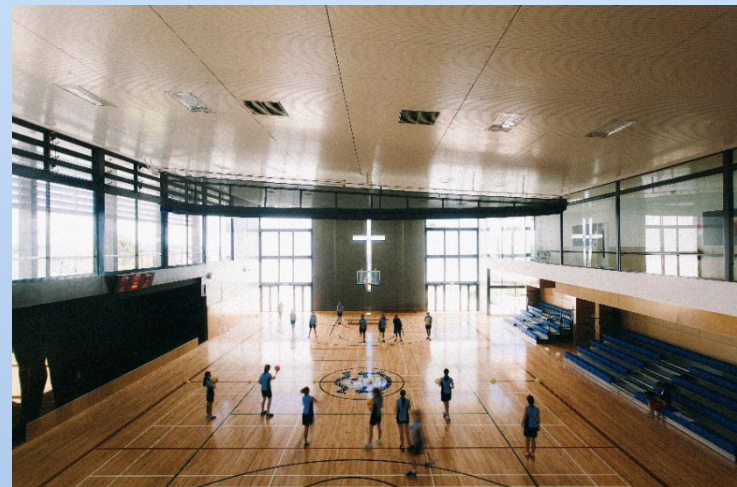
