# Welcome to SMC Music

St Mary's College has an amazing musical tradition, which continues to this day.

All St Mary's students in Years 7 - 9 learn a Band or Orchestra instrument for three years and play in an ensemble (St Mary's College Compulsory Music Scheme).

Students have a <u>one-hour</u> timetabled lesson a week on a Thursday morning. In addition, they have <u>one half-hour</u> small group lesson a week with an Itinerant Teacher of Music (ITM) . The lesson schedule can be seen on the Music Department notice board.
